**SUPPLY LIST for quilt size 51" x 67" (block size 8")**

**For two placemats, you will need:**

**1 yard for the placemat front and back**

**Two 7 ½ inch squares for placemat centers**

**¾ yard for center diamonds, setting triangles and diamond back**

**1/8 yard for trim on center diamond**

**Steam-a-seam 2**

**Light-weight batting**

Sewing machine & standard sewing supplies (matching thread, scissors, seam ripper, etc.)

Quarter-inch (1/4) foot

Cutting mat & rotary cutter

6" x 24" ruler

Large square ruler

Small iron (there will be two or three irons in the classroom already)

**Prep work before class:**

Diamond center – fussy cut two (2) 7 ½ inch squares

Placemat fabric – cut four (4) 20" x "14" rectangles

Accent fabric – cut the following:

Four (4) 6" squares for setting triangles

Eight (8) 3 ¾ " squares for placemat corners

Two (2) 11" squares for diamond back

For trim cut: four (4) 1" x 42" strips
