## CURVES AROUND THE RECTANGLE with JUDY SISNEROS

Start with a $12 \frac{1}{1}$ " x $241 / 2$ rectangle of a gorgeous fabric, add blocks with gradual curves to create a quilt with beauty and movement. You can also use a panel cut to this size.
Intermediate level or confident beginner.

## SUPPLY LIST

Sewing machine in good working order, new needle
Thread to match fabric, full bobbin
Scissors, pins, seam ripper
Rotary cutter (sharp blade!!), cutting mat (at least 24 " long)
Marking pencils - light and dark
$6 \frac{1}{2}$ " square ruler and $121 / 2$ " square ruler
24" long ruler (or $241 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ )
Post-it notes
Fleece/flannel attached to design surface at least 32" x 40"
OPTIONAL: if you have June Tailor "Shape Cut" for cutting strips, bring it!

## FABRIC:

Focus fabric - $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $24 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle**
2 Fabrics - used in curved blocks \& rail fence blocks - 1 1/4 yard EACH
(Should be high contrast to each other)
Inner border \& rail fence blocks - 1 yard small print or tone on tone**
**Note: If your large rectangle is not a panel, but a large-scale print, bring $1 \frac{1}{2}$ yards and use it for both rectangle \& inner border/rail fence block.

## SUPPLY LIST

Sewing machine in good working order, new needle
Thread to match fabric, full bobbin
Scissors, pins, seam ripper
Rotary cutter (sharp blade!!), cutting mat (at least 24 " long)
Marking pencils - light and dark
$6 \frac{1}{2}$ " square ruler and $121 / 2$ " square ruler
24 " long ruler (or $241 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ )
Fleece/flannel attached to design surface at least 32" x 40"

* DO NOT FORGET THIS ITEM!!

FABRIC:
$13 / 4$ yds. Large scale focus fabric (includes enough for $12 \times 18$ rectangle)
$1 / 2$ yd. contrasting fabric for blocks around rectangle
1 yd. fabric to use with focus fabric for outer blocks/binding

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
